

Asthma Friendly Schools Checklist

Criterion/evidence required	Tick when met
Local Authority or other approved Asthma/Medical Needs Policy Adopted • Cite the LA policy adopted or include other policy with the submission	
 The school has a member of staff named as the asthma lead Name, designation, and contact details to be provided 	
The school has an up-to-date register of pupils with asthma • Number of pupils and details of how the register is updated required	
At least 85% of school staff have completed asthma training in the last 12 months • Training details/specification required	
School staff can recognise and support a pupil who is having an asthma attack • Examples of strategies in place required e.g. posters, training log	
All pupils with asthma have easy access to their reliever inhaler whilst in the care of school • Inhalers must not be locked away (except in agreed special circumstances) • Inhalers should be visible and accessible within classrooms or carried/managed by pupils themselves	
 The school maintains a stock of 1 or more emergency reliever (salbutamol) inhalers and spacer devices or a spare reliever inhaler for each pupil on the school asthma register School has at least 1 emergency salbutamol inhaler stored in a central location and a supply of spacer devices for single use with the emergency inhaler OR School stores a spare reliever inhaler for each pupil of the school asthma register 	
Any use of the emergency (or spare) inhaler by a pupil is recorded and communicated to parents • Details of record keeping, and communication required
